PE & SPORT AT CATERHAM

Caterham Sport is a forward thinking and dynamic department with a proven successful track record in both performance sport and participation levels. Caterham sport is a programme that prides itself on providing sporting opportunities that challenge and motivate all pupils to develop a passion for sport and physical activity.

The development of individuals (both in a sporting and character sense) is central to our ethos and we create supportive environments where all pupils are encouraged to make decisions, be creative and take risks. We pursue excellence and strive for success for individuals and teams at local, regional and national levels by extending the elite performers as well as those who participate at a more recreational level.

We firmly believe that both participation and performance are achievable simultaneously and we strive to give pupils the opportunities that are most appropriate to them and their goals. As such, we have in excess of a thousand fixtures a year, with a regular Saturday fixture programme. Our focus sports include Rugby, Lacrosse, Netball, Hockey, Cricket, Tennis, Athletics and Swimming but there are in excess of twenty sports available to pupils at Caterham.

We achieve enviable success on the sports field, regularly reaching latter stages of local, regional and national competitions. With a large number of pupils achieving representative honours, our ability to develop elite sports people is excellent. We are also extremely proud of the fact that more than 70% of pupils regularly represent the school in competitive fixtures. Teaching and coaching is provided by highly skilled practitioners and supported by external specialist coaches where required.

The Caterham Athlete Programme is our value-added scholarship and elite sportsperson programme that seeks to develop our most able pupils through additional coaching, mentoring, lectures and interactive sessions in a range of sporting topics.

The exceptional sporting facilities which make all of this possible include some of the very best grass pitches in the south of England, a floodlit Astroturf, a 25 metre indoor swimming pool, five netball courts and state-of-the-art performance gym. A 7 minute walk from school will bring you to Hill Fields, our extended and recently renovated additional sports facilities that include a new sports pavilion and numerous Lacrosse, Rugby and Cricket pitches.

THE ROLE AT CATERHAM

We are looking for an outstanding Graduate Assistant to join our positive, dynamic and forward-thinking Physical Education department at our Senior School.

Graduate Assistants are timetabled to teach and assist with all the Department’s PE and Games lessons. In addition to assisting with the organisation of equipment and supporting pupils with particular needs.

This is a flexible arrangement, depending on individual capabilities in the various sports. In ‘free’ lessons or when not required to play an active teaching role graduate assist with sport administration.

The ideal candidate will have a passion for sport, a desire to work in a team and a commitment to helping students reach their potential.

Main Duties:

- 1. Teach sport in timetabled lessons
- 2. Coach the teams in practices and matches after school
- 3. Umpire or referee matches
- 4. Organise kit for lessons and fixtures
- 5. Support the CAP programme at lunchtimes

After school and on Saturdays, Sport Graduate Assistants contribute to sports practices and matches. This could be as either a coach or official.

Graduates undertake other school-based duties as and when required, such as supervising in the classroom for absent staff, and assisting in the main School Office and at school functions.
