1. Job Purpose Statement

Undertake planned, preventative maintenance on the Airfield lighting systems ensuring that all tasks are completed safely and in a timely manner. Ensure that AGL systems maintain compliance with regulatory requirements set by ICAO and the UK CAA. Work to departmental standards and practices within specified timescales and within budget constraints. In the event of system faults or failures, provide a swift and efficient response meeting specified SLAs. Ensure an accurate and effective fault diagnosis is conducted to identify root cause prior to rectification, minimising system downtime, reducing disruption to passengers and service partners. Prioritise and quality assess all work whilst communicating effectively with Customer and service partners, championing continuous improvement to safeguard operations and increase service uptimes. Operate an on-call system to ensure asset and equipment service level agreements and KPI's are met 24/7.

2. Principal Accountabilities

2.1. Undertake planned and reactive maintenance activities to all Airfield systems ensuring compliance with, CAP 1168 and other relevant UK CAA regulations. This includes PAPI's, approach, runway, and taxiway lighting, stop bars and illuminated signs.

2.2. provide maintenance and support of the Airfield lighting circuits and systems, Airfield regulators and its' associated control system.

2.3. Conduct regulatory MALMS runway lighting inspections in line with planned maintenance activities.

2.4. Undertake planned and reactive maintenance to the Airfield and Car Park High Mast lighting.

2.5. Maintain and support the Airfield backup electrical generators ensuring the units are operable 24/7.

2.6. Maintain the Airfield Stand guidance systems to CAA regulations.

2.7. Utilise the Airports electronic maintenance system to input relevant information to enable accurate recording and analysis of all maintenance activities.

2.8. Liaise with external contractors ensuring a high quality of work standards are maintained in compliance with health and safety regulations.

2.9. Liaise with the AGL team leader to support the control and supply of equipment, parts and consumables that are required for all maintenance activities.

2.10. Communicate daily with other departments such as Air Traffic Control and Airfield Operations to ensure consistency in all matters, attending regular update meetings as required.

2.11. Any other ad-hoc duties which may occur from time to time and are considered to be within the post holders' capability, to ensure business continuity.

3. Additional Responsibilities

Safety

Whilst at work the postholder will be expected to comply and co-operate with the company's Safety Management System (SMS) and is reminded of the employee's responsibilities as detailed in Sections 7 & 8 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974. The post holder will:

- Take reasonable care of the health and safety of him/herself and other persons who may be affected by his/her acts or omissions at work.
- Co-operate with the Company management so far as is necessary in order that the Company can carry out its statutory duty under the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and all relevant statutory provisions.
- Not intentionally or recklessly interfere with or misuse anything provided in the interests of health, safety and welfare.
- In addition, the postholder will comply with the more specific requirements contained within the Safety Management System and associated documents.

Environmental

Whilst at work the post holder will be expected to take into consideration how their individual and collective actions may affect the Airport Company's overall sustainability objectives and compliance with environmental guidance and legislation.

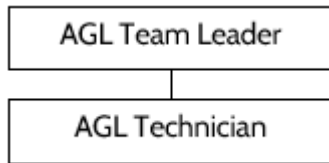
- Take responsibility for their actions and co-operate with the Airport Company management so far as possible to minimise and prevent the potential pollution of the local environment.

Security

Whilst working at the airport, security is a responsibility of every employee. It is everyone's duty to:

- Monitor and report any persons: loitering in or around restricted areas, taking an interest in CCTV cameras, closely watching staff movements, appearing highly agitated or nervous.
- If something doesn't feel right, trust your instinct, and report it to a member of security.
