

Purpose / Added Value:

This includes ownership and oversight of PPV reporting methodologies, savings metrics, and working capital such as payment terms.</p> <p>The Procurement Finance Lead is expected to proactively and continuously identify opportunities for improvement across cost, cash, reporting processes, and decision making. Acting as a bridge between Finance and Procurement, the role enables informed decision making through clear, reliable insights, and supports sustainable value delivery across the organisation.</p>

Own the development and delivery of accurate and timely weekly and monthly management packs</p> <p>Governance, Controls and Compliance: Ensure strong financial controls within procurement processes and support governance and compliance around internal policies and audit requirements, relevant SOx controls and supplier rebates</p> <p>Team Leadership and Capability Building: Lead and develop procurement finance accountant, embedding strong financial rigour, as well as building financial capability and commercial awareness within non finance teams as appropriate.</p>
